



**WHEREAS**, the Board has held the Hearing and heard objections to the Additional Assessment Roll, copies of which, if any, are on file with the Township Clerk;

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that the Additional Assessments are necessary to supply the deficiency between the remaining balances due on the Special Assessment District assessment roll of August 14, 1997 and the remaining principal and interest on the bonds issued in anticipation of the assessments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The Additional Assessment Roll, assessing the sum of Two Thousand Fifty-five and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,055.00) against each of the parcels within the Special Assessment District established for Homer Township Water District 1 (a/k/a Water District A), is confirmed.

2. The Township Clerk shall endorse on the Additional Assessment Roll, today's date as the date of confirmation.

3. The Additional Assessments shall be payable in seven (7) equal annual installments, the first of which shall be due on December 1, 2010 and on December 1 of each subsequent year through December 1, 2016.

4. Additional Assessments may be paid in full through December 1, 2010 without interest. Commencing December 1, 2010 all Additional Assessments shall bear interest at the rate of 1% greater than the bond interest rate, per annum. Future due installments of a special assessment may be paid in full, with interest accrued through the month in which the final installment is paid.

5. On March 1 of each year, beginning on March 1, 2011, the unpaid amount of the installments that became due and payable on the next preceding December 1 shall be deemed delinquent, and there shall be collected a penalty at the rate of 1% for each month or fraction of a month that such amount remains unpaid after the date on which such amount was deemed delinquent, until such amount is reported to the Township Board for reassessment on the Township's tax roll.

6. The Township Clerk is hereby directed to attach a warrant to the Additional Assessment Roll and to deliver such warrant and the Roll to the Township Treasurer, who shall thereupon collect the additional assessments in accordance with the terms of this resolution, such warrant and the statutes of the State of Michigan.

7. The form and content of the notice published and mailed to property owners in the Special Assessment District on the direction of the Township Clerk with

respect to the aforementioned public hearing, and all actions of Township officials in scheduling such hearing, are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.

8. All previous resolutions, or parts of previous resolutions, of the Board that are inconsistent with this resolution are hereby rescinded.
